

Commitment Declaration

Our company complies with the requirements set out in the EU Renewable Energy Directive (EU RED), as amended by Directive (EU) 2023/2413. We verify that biomass is not sourced from land with the status referred to in Articles 29(3)(a), (b), (d) and (e), 29(4)(a), and 29(5) of the EU RED, under the conditions specified therein. Accordingly, biomass is not sourced from old-growth forests or protected heathlands, and sourcing is conducted in line with requirements for the protection of highly biodiverse forests, grasslands, wetlands, and peatlands.

Data management and mass-balance accounting are carried out in accordance with the principles and requirements of EU RED–approved certification schemes, ensuring traceability of sustainable biomass flows.

LEAG Pellets implements the cascading principle by sourcing biomass within permissible feedstock categories in accordance with applicable regulatory and certification requirements.

At our company, we engage with stakeholders and business partners through open and constructive dialogue. We actively monitor and follow developments in regulatory frameworks, implementing new legal and sustainability requirements related to wood resources in a timely manner.
